Baptism Registration

Celebrating Your Child/Children's Baptism



You are planning to have your child baptized. In doing so you are accepting the responsibility of training your child in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring this child up to keep God's commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and one another.

General Information

Baptism Requirement:

One of the child/children's parents must be a practicing Catholic and a member of St. Augustine's Parish. If not a resident of St. Augustine's Parish, permission from the pastor of the Parish in which the parent resides is required.

Baptism Preparation Class:

At least one parent, (*preferably both parents*), is required to attend the Baptism Preparation class held at the Parish Centre - 2028 West 7th Avenue. Registration begins at 6:30PM. The session lasts approximately 1 1/2 hours and is held on the first Thursday of every month.

NOTE: *If a child is not baptized before school entrance, another class is required prior to Baptism CIC (Christian Initiation for Children).*

The Baptism Registration form must be completed. It is important that all information requested be provided. Please print clearly. Forms are available at the Preparation Class, or in the foyer of the Church or at the Parish Office.

Godparents:

Sponsors must be at least one practicing Catholic having received the Sacraments of Catholic Initiation, i.e. Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist and, if you wish, one baptized witness. A Godparent by proxy is permitted with permission from the priest.

White Garment:

If you do not have a white baptismal gown, the Parish has one for infants approximately 6 months and under that you may use for the Baptism day if you wish. Contact the Parish Office.

Baptism Celebration Day:

Please arrive at the Church at least 10 minutes before Mass begins.

Please remember to allow time for feeding/changing your baby. Also, bring the pacifier or whatever makes your baby happy. It is their day!

Photographs:

Photographs are taken during the Baptism celebration only. Photographers are not allowed in the sanctuary or near the sanctuary. The front pew is the best place for the photographers. Taking photographs is also permitted after the Mass.

A Baptism Certificate is issued and will be presented to you after the Baptism. Please check it to ensure all the information is correct.

Stole Fee

"A stole is a financial donation paid by a lay person to the Church and/or a priest for administering a Sacrament or Rite."

Donations to the Church and/or the priest are appreciated. Please mark each envelope separately if you choose to do this.

Scheduling a Baptism:

Baptisms must be scheduled through the Parish Office at 604 736-4455 (Extension 221) during office hours 9:00AM to 5:00PM, Monday to Friday. We recommend they be scheduled at least one month in advance of the anticipated date, with the understanding that the Baptism Preparation Class will have taken place before the Baptism.

Baptisms will be scheduled for taking place at a Mass. Please refer to the Schedule for Baptism date and time. Baptisms are administered by the priest celebrant scheduled for the Mass selected.
